Job

The **Plumber** is responsible for installing, repairing, and maintaining pipes, fixtures, and other plumbing used for water distribution and wastewater disposal in our residential buildings.

This position reports directly to the Maintenance Manager who assigns day-to-day work and oversees general duties. The Plumber also receives general guidance and daily work orders from the Manager of Real Estate Operations.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for full completion of work orders within a designated time period, completed within the turnover month
- Ensure good tenant relations by scheduling repairs and maintenance within an approved time period
- Install, repair, and maintain plumbing systems and components
- Review building plans and specifications to determine the layout for plumbing and related materials
- Identify required tools and special equipment
- Install, repair, and maintain water treatment equipment, piping and controls, storm sanitary and water piping systems, sinks, tubs and toilets, water heaters and conditioners, plumbing fixtures, appliances and trim
- Maintain all building codes, installation requirements and relevant legislation
- Perform scheduled maintenance service on plumbing systems and fixtures
- Apply all codes to installations, repairs and maintenance
- Ensure all requirements as specified by the manufacturer of systems and fixtures are met
- Ensure all installations, repairs, and maintenance are properly sized, aligned, supported, and graded
